Respected Sir,

Assalam O' Aleykum wa Rahmat'Allah

My friend, aged 27 and half, dreamt Masjid-e-Nabvi (PBUH) and the Holy grave of Prophet Mohammed (PBUH) in detail, this morning (May 28, 2007) around 6:30 am, or so it appeared.

He's trying to offer all Fard (compulsory) prayers and even Tahajjud (Optional Late night Prayer/Nawafil) by the grace of Almighty Allah. He has, naturally just like all other Muslim fellows, an increased affinity with Holy Prophet (PBUH) and one of his aspirations is to work (Job) for Masjid-e-Nabvi (PBUH). Consequently, he thinks every now and then about the same. He also visited shrines and mausoleums of saints to offer Fateha and Dua etc.

Last night, as he tells, after intimacy with his wife, he took bath and offered nawafil. Prior to intimacy his wife discussed with him his craving to work in/for Masjid-e-Nabvi (PBUH) when he, while repressing his long old desire, answered her in one line, "It's easy to get Jann'a (Heaven) in the hereafter than to get a job in Masjid-e-Nabvi (PBUH) in this life".

Now the Dream:

He finds himself, in a vehicle of current times, along with his mother and wife, zooming towards Medina. The buildings, he sees along the roadside, are sort of castles, big spacious and tall bungalows with fewer palm trees. He then arrives at the holy Masjid-e-Nabvi (PBUH) and the outlook of the mosque is same as he's seen in TV and other graphic media. He could see the main green Dome (Gunbad-e-Khazra) and the accompanying minaret along with the rest of the complex. Then he finds himself sitting on the Mosque's floor among many other people in a Hall as if they were waiting for the Zuhar Prayer or their turn to visit the place where Holy Prophet (PBUH) is exactly resting. Through the arcs, he couldn't see the Main Dome but the rest of the complex so, in ultimate zeal, he makes his way to the front row to a position where he could have a broader view. Lo' he sees the Main Dome and the Minaret with absolute clarity within a mind-reviving close proximity. But he witnesses the Prophet's resting place in a center of a courtyard – sort of isolated from the place/hall where they all were sitting – partially populated with children of all ages sitting at the floor in a Salat-posture, with some of them changing their places, walking or amusing thereon. He dares to enter in that courtyard where no other adult from the Hall dared to, and find an Arab with a beard and a white dress sitting on a chair with a scepter as a mentor/teacher of those children. That Arab calls him and asks him his name and where he was from and what he was doing there at that time? He starts crying with tears and excitement being that close in Prophet's Mosque

(PBUH) and answers all his questions. The Arab first admonishes him through a quit crying and get real, no fake pep-talk then asks him to leave as this was not the suitable time, upon some abject appeals & pleas, he, with ambience, tells him that he could return at Asr and could stay up to either Maghrib or Isha at his convenience. On his way back to the Hall, again he swerves to the Holy Prophet's resting place – A room with see through grilles and a door opened for him. He stands at the door and quickly takes a view of the room inside where he finds a Holy Grave covered with Green sheet and a black border. The feeling was over-whelming. He returns to the Hall and there he finds couple of youth of his own nationality, sitting next to him, playing with their mobile phones and he wonders that what are these guys doing (Playing with their mobile phones and chatting) in a place of highest reverence. The next moment the same two guys are called-in and from the front row he sees them inside the central room through the see through grille. At that point of time he feels quite jealous and wonders in his mind as how come these two indifferent guys have been officially called inside the room (apparently they were devoid of appropriate manners and that he was asked to return at Asr), the moment this thoughts zooms in his mind the Dream is over!!!

Dear Sir, how would you comment on this? Was that real, whatever he saw? Or due to his suppressed desires, his mind made out all this. Should he discuss these kind of dreams with his friends and families? How to find a job in Masjid-e-Nabvi (PBUH)?

I shall be grateful to you, if you explain in detail of what you figured out of this so that I could convey it further to my friend who is constantly asking me for the answer(s).

3. He recently visited the holy shrine of a South East Asian Saint who had that Green Sheet over the grave but with the calligraphy on it i.e. Different than the one he dreamt.

All the time during the dream, the most striking thought was that he's inside Holy Prophet's Mosque (PBUH), but the mosque's inside structure/design was slightly different that the original one (probably as he's never seen the mosque from the inside.)

Dear Dr. Umar Azam,

Salam O Aleykum, and thank you very much for dedicating your time to my query and your comments on that. I would like to draw your attention to the fact that in his dream he didn't see the Rauze (tombs) of Saints rather he stepped inside the very Rauze of Prophet Muhammad (Peace be Upon Him) himself or so it appeared.

He saw a quite prominent grave covered with a Green sheet with Black border and on the right and left of that grave he saw a bed (charpaai in Urdu) stalled against the wall in horizontal position. So he saw two beds, not in their laid position (rather in a position when they are not used), but stalled against the wall horizontally on the right and left of the holy grave.

Salaam uncle, how are you? It has been along time since we last spoke, what are you up to these days? I have currently finished my degree in Civil Engineering at Salford University, just waiting for my graduation on July 18th 2007. Uncle I need your help, I have been accused for using misconduct in one of my exams in January 2007 which the accusation was false as I mistakenly took unauthorized material into the examination. On my behalf I know the university rules and it was a forgetful mistake. I was then reported to the Disciplines Committee that took place in April which decide if I was guilty or not, a decision was recently made that I was guilty for breaching the misconduct rules and the penalty was a score of zero for that module and for my remaining 11 modules to be capped at 40% which I find very harsh that I gained no advantage.
