A number of works have been authored concerning this topic or discussing this topic. Amongst them are: Ibn Taymiyyah's Al-Jawaab-us- Sahih Li Man Baddala Din al-Masih; what was mentioned by Ibn Kathir in Tarikh and az-Zahabi in Tarikh al-Islam; Ibn Hajr in Fath-ul-Bari (6/582). Refer also to Khair-ud-Din Wanili's Mu`jizat al-Mustafa. Consult this for the evidences for what is mentioned in this article.

The Messenger of Allah, Muhammad, (Sall Allaho alaihe wasallam) possesses many manifest miracles and signs demonstrating his veracity, reaching thousands and they are well-known. From amongst them is the Holy Qur'aan, the manifest and clear miracle and brilliant proof, falsehood cannot approach it from before it or behind it. It is a revelation from the One Who is All-Wise and Praiseworthy. It incapacitated that the most eloquent of people in the most eloquent of times were unable to produce a single chapter that would be comparable to the Holy Qur'aan. And cannot be able to do it in future even if the whole of creation were to gather for that purpose. Allah the Exalted says:

"Say: If the whole of mankind and the jinn gathered in order to produce the like of this Qur'aan, they could not produce the like of it, even if they assisted each other." [Al-Israa' 17: 88]

It challenged them to this despite their large numbers, their eloquence and their severe enmity, and it challenges them to this day.

As for the other miracles of the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam), it is not possible to enumerate them all due to their huge number and renewing and increasing nature. However, I will mention some examples:

- * The splitting of the moon,
- * Water flowing from between his fingers,
- * Increase in the quantity of food and water,
- * The glorification of the food,
- * The palm tree yearning for him,
- * Stones greeting him,
- * The talking of the poisoned leg of roasted sheep to him,
- * Trees walking towards him,
- * Two trees that were far apart, coming together and then parting again,
- * The barren and therefore dry sheep giving milk,
- * The return of the eye of Hadhrat Qatadah bin an-No`man (Radhi Allahu anho) at its place because of the touch of the hand of the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) after it had slipped out,
- * His spitting lightly into the eye of Hadhrat Ali (Radhi Allahu anho) when it had become inflamed and its being cured almost immediately,
- * His wiping the leg of Hadhrat Abdullah bin Atiq (Radhi Allahu anho) whereupon he was immediately cured,
- * His informing of the places of death of the infidels on the Day of Badr by saying, 'This is the place of such polytheists.'
- * His informing about the killing of Ubayy bin Khalaf,
- * His prediction that a group of his nation would traverse an ocean and Umm Haram would be amongst them and this occurred,
- * That all that was drawn together for him of the ends of the earth and displayed to him, would be opened for his nation,

- * His prediction that the treasures of Chosroes would be spent by his nation in the Way of Allah, the Mighty and Magnificent,
- * That he feared for his nation that they would be tempted by the wealth and allurements of this world and that the treasures of the Persians and Romans would be ours and that Suraqah bin Malik would wear the bracelets of Chosroes.
- * He informed us that Hadhrat Hasan bin Ali (Radhi Allahu anho) would reconcile between two large warring parties of the Muslims,
- * He informed that Hadhrat Sa'ad bin Abi Waqqas (Radhi Allahu anho) would live such that nations would benefit by him and others would be harmed,
- * He informed that he an-Najashi had died on this particular day, while he was in Ethiopia and that al-Aswad al-Ansi had been killed on this particular day, while he was in Yemen,
- * He predicted that the Muslims would fight the Turks who were described as having small eyes, wide faces and small, chiselled noses and that Yemen, Syria and Iraq would be conquered by the Muslims.
- * He informed us that the Muslims would comprise three armies, an army in Syria, an army in Yemen and an army in Iraq,
- * He predicted that they would conquer Egypt, a land whose [unit of land measurement] was the Qirat, that they should deal with their people well for they have protection [being Copts] and ties of kinship [through Hajar],
- * He informed that Awais al-Qarni (Rahmatullah alaihe) would come to you from the auxiliaries of Yemen, he would be afflicted with leprosy and it would be healed except for the space of a dirham, and he indeed arrived during the rule of Hadhrat Umar (Radhi Allahu anho),
- * He informed us that a group of his nation would always be upon the truth,
- * He predicted that mankind would become many in number,
- * He predicted that the Ansaar would diminish in number and that the Ansaar would not be given their due with regards distribution of wealth and leadership,
- * He said that mankind would keep on asking questions until they would say, "Allah created the creation..." [Referring to the Hadith, "The people would continue asking until they say, 'this is Allah Who created everything.. .but who created Allah?'" (Bukhari and Muslim)]
- * He informed us that Ruwayfi` bin Thabit would live a long life,
- * He predicted that Hadhrat Ammar bin Yasir (Radhi Allahu anho) would be killed by the transgressing group,
- * He foretold that this nation shall divide into sects and that they would fight each other,
- * He informed us that a fire would emanate from the land of Hijaz and the likes of this. All of this occurred exactly as the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) said it would.

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) said to Hadhrat Thabit bin Qais (Radhi Allahu anho), "You will live being praised... and you will die as a martyr", and he lived being praised and was martyred at al-Yamamah,

* He said to Hadhrat Usman (Radhi Allahu anho): "He would be afflicted by a severe trial." [The meaning of severe trial is his being imprisoned in his house and his being killed by the transgressors.]

* He said about a person amongst the Muslims who had just fought a severe fight that: "He would be from amongst the denizens of the Fire", and later that person committed suicide,

* Wabisah bin Ma`bad came to the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) in order to ask him about righteousness and sin and before him asking the question, the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) asked him, "Have you come to ask about righteousness and sin?"

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) said to Hadhrat Ali, Hadhrat Zubair and Hadhrat Miqdad (Radhi Allahu anhum): "Go to the garden of Khakh for indeed there is Dha`inah" who has a book with her. [Dha`inah is the woman with whom Hatib bin Abi al-Balta`ah (Radhi Allahu anho) sent a letter to the people of Makkah in order to inform them about the plans of the Messenger of Allah (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) to fight them. It was concerning this that the first verses of Surah Mumtahinah were revealed. The garden of Khakh is a place falling between Makkah and Madinah. Refer to Bukhari [no 3983] and Muslim [no 2494] and Tafsir Ibn Kathir [4/344]]. They found her there but she initially denied having the book and then took it out from within her braids,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) said to Hadhrat Abu Hurairah (Radhi Allahu anho) when Satan had stolen some dates: "Indeed he shall return," and he did,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) said to his wives, "The most prolific of you in giving charity will be the quickest of you to join me." And it was so. Zaynab bint Jahsh (Radhi Allahu anha) was the most prolific of them in giving charity and was the first to die. [Refer to Sahih Muslim no 2452]

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) said to 'Abdullah bin Salaam, "You will remain upon Islam until you die."

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated for Hadhrat Anas (Radhi Allahu anho) that his wealth and sons may increase and that he should live a long life, and it was so. He lived for more than one hundred years and none of the Ansaar was richer than him and one hundred and twenty of his children had already been buried before the arrival of al-Hajjaj [to Basrah]. This is detailed further in Sahih Bukhari and others. [Bukhari no 1982]

* He supplicated that Islam be strengthened through Umar bin al-Khattab or Abu Jahl, and Allah strengthened it through Hadhrat Umar (Radhi Allahu anho),

* He supplicated against Suraqah bin Maalik and the feet of Suraqah's horse sank into the earth and he was thrown off, he called out asking for safe conduct and was granted it by the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam), then he asked him to make a supplication for him,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated that Allah may remove the feeling of the bitter cold and heat from Hadhrat Ali (Radhi Allahu anho), and so never did he feel cold or hot,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated for Hadhrat Huziafah (Radhi Allahu anho), the night that he sent him to spy on the Confederates, and he did not feel the cold until he returned from the mission,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated for Hadhrat Abdullah bin Abbas (Radhi Allahu anho) that Allah may grant him understanding of the religion and it was so,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated against Utbah bin Abi Lahb that Allah may cause a dog from amongst his dogs to overcome him. Utbah was then killed by a lion at az-Zarqa`,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated for the descent of rain when people asked him to at the time of drought. There was not a single cloud in the sky at that time, and then when he had supplicated, clouds gathered like mountains and it rained until the next Friday. It rained so much that people had to come back and ask him to supplicate and stop the rain, so he supplicated and the rain stopped and they walked out into the glaring sun,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated for Hadhrat Abu Talhah (Radhi Allahu anho) and his wife, Hadhrat Umm Sulaim (Radhi Allahu anha) that Allah may bless them in the night they had spent together, and she became pregnant and gave birth to Abdullah, who had nine children and all of them were scholars,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) supplicated for the mother of Hadhrat Abu Hurairah (Radhi Allahu anho) that she be guided and Hadhrat Abu Hurairah (Radhi Allahu anho) left to find her performing the ritual bath because she had accepted Islam. He supplicated for Umm Qais bint Muhsin, the sister of Ukkasha, that she live a long life and we do not know of another woman who lived as long as she did. This was reported by an-Nasa'i the chapter concerning washing the deceased,

* On the Day of Hunain, the Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) threw a handful of dirt at the disbelievers and said, "May the faces be disfigured", and Allah the Exalted vanquished them, filling their eyes with dirt,

* The Holy Prophet (Sall Allahu alaihe wasallam) once went out to one hundred of the Quraish, who were waiting to do something horrible to him and he put dirt on their head and went on his way without being seen by them.

Twelve Proofs that Muhammad is a True Prophet

My brothers and sisters everywhere! With this essay, I am not singling out the adherents of Islam - to which I ascribe - but rather I am writing this essay to every man and woman throughout the whole world.

I ask Allah that He facilitates that this essay reaches every ear, falls under the sight of every eye, and is understood by every heart...

Muhammad the son of `Abdullah is Allah's Prophet and the Final Messenger Sent by Allah to the Inhabitants of Earth.

My brothers and sisters everywhere! You should know that the Messenger, Muhammad the son of `Abdullah (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) is Allah's Messenger in reality and truth. The evidences that show his veracity are abundant. None but an infidel, who out of arrogance alone, could deny these signs.

Among these proofs:

1. Muhammad (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) was raised illiterate, unable to read or write, and remained like that till his death. Among all his people, he was known as being truthful and trustworthy. Before receiving revelation, he had no prior knowledge of Religion or any previously sent Message. He remained like that for his first forty years. Revelation then came to Muhammad with the Koran that we now have between our hands. This Koran mentioned most of the accounts found in the previous scriptures, telling us about these events in the greatest detail as if he witnessed them. These accounts came precisely as they were found in the Torah sent down to Moses and in the Gospel sent down to Jesus. Neither the Jews or Christians were able to belie him regarding anything that he said.

2. Muhammad (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) also foretold of everything that would occur to him and his community after him, pertaining to victory, the removal of the tyrannical kingdoms of Chosroes [the royal title for the Zoroastrian kings of Persia] and Caesar, and the establishment of the religion of Islam throughout the earth. These events occurred exactly as Muhammad foretold, as if he was reading the future from an open book.

3. Muhammad (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) also brought an Arabic Koran that is the peak of eloquence and clarity. The Koran challenged those eloquent and fluent Arabs of his time, who initially belied him, to bring forth a single chapter like the Koran. The eloquent Arabs of his day were unable to contest this Koran.

Indeed, till our day, none has ever dared to claim that he has been able to compose words that equal- or even approach- the order, grace, beauty, and splendor of this Glorious Koran.

4. The life history of this Noble Prophet was a perfect example of being upright, merciful, compassionate, truthful, brave, generous, distant from all evil character, and ascetic in all worldly matters, while striving solely for the reward of the Hereafter. Moreover, in all his actions and dealings, he was ever mindful and fearful of Allah.

5. Allah instilled great love for Muhammad (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) in the hearts of all who believed in and met him. This love reached such a degree that any of his companions would willingly sacrifice his (or her) self, mother or father for him.

Till today, those who believe in Muhammad honor and love him. Anyone of those who believe in him would ransom his own family and wealth to see him, even if but once.

6. All of history has not preserved the biography of any person in the manner it has preserved the life of Muhammad, who is the most influential human in history.

Nor has the entire earth known of anyone whom every morning and evening, and many times thereafter throughout the day, is thought of by those who believe in him. Upon remembering Muhammad, the believers in him will greet him and ask Allah to bless him. They do such with full hearts and true love for him.

7. Nor has there ever been a man on earth whom is still followed in all his doings by those who believe in him.

Those who believe in Muhammad, sleep in the manner he slept; purify themselves (through ablution and ritual washing) in the manner he purified himself; and adhere to his practice in the way they eat, drink, and clothe themselves.

Indeed in all aspects of their lives, the believers in Muhammad adhere to the teachings he spread among them and the path that he traveled upon during his life.

During every generation, from his day till our time, the believers in this Noble Prophet have fully adhered to his teachings. With some, this has reached the degree that they desire to follow and adhere to the Prophet's way in his personal matters regarding which Allah has not sought of them to

adhere to in worship. For example, some will only eat those specific foods or only wear those specific garments that the Messenger liked.

Let alone all that, all those who believe in Muhammad repeat those praises of Allah, special prayers, and invocations that he would say during each of his actions during day and night, like: what he would say when he greeted people, upon entering and leaving the house, entering and leaving the mosque, entering and leaving the bathroom, going to sleep and awaking from sleep, observing the new crescent, observing the new fruit on trees, eating, drinking, dressing, riding, traveling and returning from travel, etc.

Let alone all that, all those who believe in Muhammad fully perform-even to the minute detail-every act of worship-like prayer, fasting, charity, and pilgrimage-as this Noble Messenger (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) taught and as he himself performed.

All of this allows those who believe in him, to live their lives in all aspects with this Noble Messenger as their example, as if he was standing before them, for them to follow in all their doings.

8. There has never been nor will there ever be a man anywhere upon this earth who has received such love, respect, honor, and obedience in all matters-small and large alike-as has this Noble Prophet.

9. Since his day, in every region of the earth and during every period, this Noble Prophet has been followed by individuals from all races, colors and peoples. Many of those who followed him were previously Christians, Jews, pagans, idolaters, or without any religion. Among those who chose to follow him, were those who were known for their sound judgment, wisdom, reflection, and foresight. They chose to follow this Noble Prophet after they witnessed the signs of his truthfulness and the evidences of his miracles. They did not choose to follow Muhammad out of compulsion or coercion or because they had adopted the ways of their fathers and mothers.

Indeed many of the followers of this Prophet (may Allah's blessings peace be upon him), chose to follow him during the time when Islam was weak, when there were few Muslims, and when there was severe persecution of his followers on earth. Most people who have followed this Prophet (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) have done so not to acquire some material benefits. Indeed many of his followers have suffered the greatest forms of harm and persecution as a result of following this Prophet. Despite all this harm and persecution, this did not turn them back from his religion.

My brethren! All of this clearly indicates to anyone possessing any sense, that this Prophet was truly and really Allah's messenger and that he was not just a man who claimed prophethood or spoke about Allah without knowledge.

10. With all this, Muhammad came with a great religion in its credal and legal make-up.

Muhammad described Allah with qualities of complete perfection, and at the same time in a manner that is free of ascribing to Him any imperfection. Neither the philosophers or the wise could ever describe Allah like such. Indeed it is impossible to imagine that any human mind could conceive of an existing being that possesses such complete ability, knowledge, and greatness; Who has subdued the creation; Who has encompassed everything in the universe, small or large; and Who possesses such perfect mercy.

Nor is it in the ability of any human being to place a perfect law based upon justice, equality, mercy and objectivity for all human activity on earth like the laws that Muhammad brought for all spheres of human activity - like buying and selling, marriage and divorce, renting, testimony, custody, and all other contracts that are necessary to uphold life and civilization on earth.

11. It is impossible that any person conceive wisdom,, morals, good manners, nobleness of characters as what this honorable Prophet (may Allah's blessings and peace be upon him) brought.

In a full and complete manner, Muhammad spread a teaching regarding character and manners toward one' parents, relatives, fiends, family, humanity, animals, plants and inanimate objects. It is impossible for the human mind alone to grasp all of that teaching or come with a similar teaching. All of that unequivocally indicates that this Messenger did not bring an) of this religion from his own accord, but that it was rather a teaching and inspiration that he received from the One Who created the earth and the high heavens above and created this universe in its miraculous architecture and perfection.
