Your dream was very hard to interpret and I'm not sure that I can interpret it exactly because it does not precisely fit any of the categories in Ibn Sireen's [R.A.] book.

I think that the dream may be suggesting that plenty of unlawful money [symbolised by worms] is being earned by your family/kin [teeth] but you, yourself, don't like this haram income [discharge of blood] and you will try to stop making use of this unpleasant income

either through a religious person close to you or through the concepts of our religion itself [buzurg].

This dream does seem to be negative if I have interpreted it correctly but, at the same time, the dream does acknowledge that you, yourself, are a righteous person who does not like to see sin being committed by those close to you. I think this dream is giving you guidance by encouraging you to *sacrifice* haram livelihood – no coincidence if you dreamt this on the day of Baqra Eid the occasion of Qurbani.

Sin that leads to Paradise

SIN may be more beneficial for a person, if it leads him to repent, than doing a lot of worship. This is what an early scholar meant when he said:

"A person may commit a sin and enter Paradise because of it, or he may do an act of worship and enter Hell because of it."

They asked: "How is that?"

He said: "He may commit a sin and continue to think about it. When he stands, sits or walks, he remembers his sin. He feels ashamed, he repents, seeks forgiveness and regrets it. So that will be the means of his salvation.(As for the other person), he may do a good deed and continue to think about it. When he stands, sits or walks he remembers it and it fills him with self-admiration and pride, so it becomes the cause of his doom."

So a sin could be the factor that leads him to do acts of worship, good deeds and change his attitude. This is better for a person than an act of worship that makes him proud and he looks down on people. Undoubtedly this sin is better before Allah and is more likely to bring salvation than one who admires himself. Even if his words indicate something else, Allah is the Witness over what is in his heart.

dear dr azam

i need some help and islamic advice and i am writing to you because i am not able to get this locally. hope you don't mind. this is strictly confidential.

anyway here goes..... i have always had a very awkward relationship with my family especially my mother. from about 13 years of age (i am now in my late 30s) i started to read namaz and quran and hadiths. before this time it was 'forced'. over the years there were times i was good and not very good. i was able to go to hajj for the first time when i was about 23.

in my opinion my mother has always had her priorities wrong - more concerned about relatives back home esp. her brothers children - who's son i was supposed to marry and didn't although his sister ended up marrying my brother.....my mother took this very very badly

my story is very long and complicated that even i don't know where to begin - it hurts my head even trying to think about it. so i will try and do a very short version

i never married and started to become the breadwinner (been working full-time since age of 17) in the family and the one who would sort out all the practical things - e.g food shopping, sorting out benefits, taking parents for appointments, a chauffeur! etc

my father died seven years ago. i had to be the 'rock' in the family while everyone and everything was falling apart. couple of years later i was diagnosed with health problems. my mother thought i was going to die and realised i was the one who was always there for her the most - my sister told me this at the time. for a couple of years we became 'close' - not the hugging type but just a bit closer than before. anyway in 2004 my younger sister got married and things changed.

today i am in a situation where nobody in my family talks to me not even extended family. i live in a house with mother and brother - nobody acknowledges my existence - not even in ramadan or on eid. i have also become hard-hearted - if you can't beat them join 'em kind of thing. they are going to pakistan today, leaving after juma - they have not told me, i heard from outside. i read fajr namaz and left for work even though i don't work on a friday (i am using work's computer!)

i feel very bitter and angry - i have done so much for my family, practically and financially and got nothing in the end. islamically i went off the rails a bit in last couple of years (Alhamdulillah now i am trying to pull myself together but have a very long way to go), stopped praying etc, went into deep depression - watched telly for hours etc. there was a few times of a so called reconciliation but every time very brief.

i have always put myself second and their needs first. even now i pay all the bills in the house and used as a babysitter when it suits them. the latter will be very strange as i look after my 2 year nephew alot even though his parents can't stand me! we are not a normal family
