Lesson 31

Surah Yaaseen - Part 5

Translation

45. When it is said to them: "Beware of that which is before you and that which is behind you so that that you may receive mercy (they turn away)".

46. Never came to them a sign from the signs of their Lord except that they turned away from it!

47. And when it is said to them: "Spend of that which Allah has provided for you", those who disbelieve say to those who believe: "Shall we feed those whom, if Allah willed, He (himself) would have fed? You are in plain error."

48. And they say: "When will this promise (i.e. resurrection) be fulfilled, if you are truthful?"

49. They await but a single shout, which will seize them while they are disputing.

50. They will not be able to make a bequest nor will they return to their family.

Commentary

Verse 45 - 46

When the disbelievers are urged to fear Allah and repent from their old ways they turn a deaf ear. An intelligent person takes a lesson from the results of his past sins and fears the consequences of his future actions. If he continuously reviews his life and prepares for the Hereafter Allah will have mercy on him and ensure a better life in his future.

An alternative commentary given of this verse is that man must learn from the punishment meted out to nations of the past that were destroyed due to their disbelief and sin. Man should similarly be fearful of the Hereafter. If he lives within these guiding lines he will be successful.

But, people who are steeped in this temporal life turn away from thinking about the Hereafter. Despite all the encouragement and warnings they are too arrogant to listen.

Verse 47

When the disbelievers are urged to spend on the less fortunate they mockingly reply: "If Allah did not give them why should we give them?"

Their statement is immersed in arrogance and blasphemy. Their arrogance is due to their shallow thinking that they have been favoured by Allah over the poor. Wealth is not a sign of success. A person may have a newspaper

as his blanket and a rock as his pillow but if he fears Allah and practices Islam he is wealthier than the richest billionaire who lives a life of sin. Their blasphemy lies in placing the blame of other's misfortunes onto Allah.

Their statement also smacks of hypocrisy. Let alone disbelief in Allah they don't even spend on the poor, an act which is accepted as good by all. However, because this encouragement comes from the believers they choose to reply mockingly. How foolish!

Logically, their statement makes no sense. They say that Allah had willed not to give them. But, now it is Allah's will to spend on them. Why do they now refuse?

Allah in His wisdom gives the rich and not the poor so that the rich can give the poor and earn reward. Allah gives wealth to people as a test to see if they would part with it. Allah can give everybody if He desires. He gives all the animals. None in the animal kingdom is richer than another. Allah in His wisdom does not give the poor so that they are in need of the resources given to the rich. The rich need the labour and effort of the poor. The world is built on mutual benefit and co-operation. Every person needs others to survive.

"You are in open error" can mean one of two things :

The disbelievers say to the believers : "Asking us to feed the poor is a foolish command."

*Allah says to the disbelievers : "By not spending on the poor you are foolish."
Verse 48 - 50*

The disbelievers mockingly ask the Muslims when the day of Qiyaamah is going to come if ever because they do not believe in Qiyaamah.

Allah does not answer their foolish question but mentions that it will come suddenly. It will be so sudden that it will seize the world while people are out and about on their normal business. An intelligent person prepares for Qiyaamah rather than ask when it will occur.

Lessons

People immersed in this material world think that they have the contacts and the means to live in their den of luxury always. Their apparent power to control people and situations gives them a feeling of independence. They subconsciously

ignore the reality of death and the accountability of the Hereafter. There is a rising trend today to ignore death and situations that remind of death. For this reason certain people do not visit the sick, they do not go to the graveyard, they do not listen to Islamic lectures on the topic, etc. These are all noteworthy but, people who are immersed in worldly pleasures steer away from reality. They prefer to live in the deceptive artificial world - a world of bright lights, jingles, mansions, entertainment and fun. A capitalist thinks precisely as explained in the Quran. Pay employees as little as possible so that they can never become independent. Subjugate them so that they will always remain employees.

Revealed At: MAKKA

In the name of Allah, the Compassionate, the Merciful.

Ayah-01

: O you who are clothed! (Muhammad)

Ayah-002

: Arise and deliver thy warning!

Ayah-003

: And your Lord do magnify,

Ayah-004

: And your garments do purify,

Ayah-005

: And uncleanness do shun,

Ayah-006

: And bestow not favors that you may receive again with increase,

Ayah-007

: And for the sake of your Lord, be patient.

Ayah-008

: Finally, when the Trumpet is sounded,

Ayah-009

: Surely that day will be a day of difficulty,
Ayah-010
: Far from easy for those without Faith(unbelievers).

Ayah-011
: Leave Me (to deal) with him whom I created lonely,

Ayah-012
: And give him vast riches,
Ayah-013
: And sons abiding in his presence

Ayah-014
: And made (life) smooth for him.

Ayah-015
: And yet he desires that I should add more!

Ayah-016
: By no means! surely he offers opposition to Our communications.

Ayah-017
: Soon I will make a distressing punishment overtake him.

Period of Revelation

The first seven verses of this Surah belong to the earliest period at Makkah. the Muslim Ummah almost unanimously agreed that the earliest Revelation to the Holy Prophet (upon whom be peace) consisted of the first five verses of Surah Al-Alaq(XCVI) However, what is established by authentic traditions is that after this first Revelation, no Revelation came down to the Holy Prophet (upon whom be peace) for quite some time. Then, when it was resumed, it started with theme verses of Surah Al- Muddaththir. Imam Zuhri has given the following details of it:

*"The Holy Messenger of Allah describing the period of **falrat al-wahi**(break in revelation) said: One day when I was passing on the way, I suddenly heard a call from heaven. I raised my head and saw that the same Angel who had visited me in the Cave of Hira was sitting on a throne between heaven and earth. This struck terror in my heart, and reaching home quickly, I said: 'Cover me up, cover me up'. So the people of the house covered me up with a quilt (or blanket). At that time Allah sent down the Revelation: **Ya ayyuhal-Muddaththiru..** From then on revelation became intense and continuous." (Bukhari, Muslim Musnad Ahmad, Ibn Jarir).*

Theme and Subject Matter

As has been explained above, the earliest Revelation to the Holy Prophet (upon whom be peace) consisted of the first five verses of Surah Al-Alaq, in which it had been Said: "Read (O Prophet), in the name of your Lord, Who created: created man from a clot of congealed blood. Read: and your Lord is Most Generous, Who taught knowledge by the pen, taught man what he did not know."

This was the first experience of Revelation met with suddenly by the Holy Prophet (upon whom be peace). in this message it was not told what great mission he had been

entrusted with and what duties he had to perform in future. He was only initiated into it and then left alone for a time so that the great strain this experience had caused should pass away and he should mentally become prepared to receive the Revelation and perform the prophetic mission in the future. After this intermission when Revelation Was resumed, the first seven verses of this Surah Were revealed: In these he Was for the first time commanded to arise and warn the people of the consequences of the way of life they were following and to proclaim the greatness of God in the world where others were being magnified without any right. Along with that he was given this instruction: The demand of the Unique mission that you have to perform, now is that your life should be pure in every respect and you should carry out the duty of reforming your people sincerely irrespective of any worldly gain. Then, in the last sentence, he was exhorted to endure with patience, for the sake of his Lord, all the hardships and troubles that he might have to face while performing his mission.

In the implementation of this Divine Command when the Holy Messenger of Allah began to preach Islam and recite the Qur'anic Surahs revealed successively, the people of Makkah felt alarmed, and it provoked a great storm of opposition and hostility

In vv. 8-10 the deniers of Truth have been warned, saying: "You will see the evil result of what you are doing today on the Resurrection Day."

In vv. 11-26, without naming Walid bin al-Mughirah, it has been told how Allah had blessed him and how inimical he proved to be to true Faith. In this connection, his mental conflict has been portrayed, telling that, on the one hand, he was fully convinced of the truth of Muhammad (upon whom be Allah's peace and blessings) and the Qur'an, but, on the other, he did not want to risk his leadership and position among his people. Therefore, not only he did not believe himself but after a long-drawn-out conflict with his conscience he also came out with the proposal that in order to restrain the people from believing the Qur'an should be branded as magic. After exposing his evil nature, it has been said: "Notwithstanding such evil inclinations and misdeeds, this person desires that he should be further blessed, whereas he has now become worthy of Hell, and never of further blessings."

In vv. 27-48, the dreadfulness of Hell has been depicted and it has been explained as to people of what character and morals really deserve it.

In conclusion, it has been explicitly stated: Allah does not stand in need of anybody's faith that He may fulfill his conditions. The Qur'an is an admonition that has been presented before the people openly; now whoever wills may accept it. Allah has a right that the people should fear His disobedience and He alone has the power to forgive the one who adopts piety and an attitude of God consciousness even though one may have committed many acts of disobedience in the past.

Lesson form this Ayah:

- *We have to wake up from Hidden Sleep.*
- *After embracing Islam the first important duty of Muslim to call to the way of Allah.*
- *First to clean our self and then try to clean the Sleeping Men.*
- *And Warn to the Sleeping Man about the Danger of the Day of Judgment.*
- *Don't bestow to get back more.*
- *be patient for the sake of your Lord,*
- *Remember the Gift of Allah*
- *Allah should not add more gift for them whose are unbelievers.*
- *A distressing punishment is waiting for those Men who forget the gifts from Allah.*

May Allah helps us to get Proper knowledge about islam and also help us to follow that properly.-----Amin.
